

Mortar Mix

Description

Pakmix® Mortar Mix is a specially formulated blend of Masonry cement and fine sand. This product is ideal for use in the laying of brick, block or stone. All ingredients are thoroughly premixed to ensure maximum strength and workability. Simply add water. Pakmix® Mortar Mix meets or exceeds the strength requirements of ASTM C-387 for Type N Mortar when used as directed.

Suggested Uses

- Laying brick
- Setting blocks
- Tuck pointing
- Patching

- Stuccoing
- Repairing chimneys
- Stone work

Preparation

All surfaces should be clean and free of oil, gas, paint, grease, etc. before applying the mix.

Directions for Mixing

Pour the estimated amount of Pakmix® Mortar Mix into a clean wheelbarrow, mortar box or similar easy-to-use container. Form a crater with a shovel or hoe in the center of the dry mix. Pour clean water into the crater at a rate of approximately 1 quart per 15 lbs of dry material. If the mix is too stiff, add more water 1 cup at a time. The mix should have the consistency of thick batter.

Items You May Need

- Mortar box or wheelbarrow
- Regular or rectangular trowel
- Shovel or hoe

- Snap line and level
- Hammer
- Chisel

Packaging and Yields

60 lb bag will lay approximately 20 - $8" \times 16"$ blocks or 48 common bricks with a 3/8" joint. Approximately 3/5 cu ft wet volume.

For Best Results

Use only when temperature is 40° F and rising. In cold weather use warm, not hot, water for mixing.

Dampen the block or the repair area before applying the new mortar to prevent premature drying of the new material.

Keep the new mortar damp for at least 3 days by an occasional fine spraying with water.

Clean Up





Clean up is easy with soap and water. Clean tools before the material hardens.
